

THE LMW MUSIC SCHOLARSHIP AWARD 2018
IMPORTANT INFORMATION AND CONDITIONS FOR APPLICANTS

The LMW Music Scholarship Award (the 'Award') of \$1000 is designed to be an annual award to a registered member of the Lake Macquarie Winds. The aim of the Award is to assist talented young musicians to reach their full potential by minimising financial considerations which may otherwise deter them.

The Award is to be used solely for the purpose(s) as stated in the application. Any exception to that purpose must be applied for in advance in writing, and approved by the Music Director of LMW (MD). Purposes should be in areas such as instrumental lesson fees, purchase of music study materials, a contribution toward purchase of a better instrument, expenses involved in attendance at master classes, or similar.

The successful Applicant will be expected to provide two written reports to the band committee for the March and September meetings respectively. The March report (250 words) will outline your musical goals and how the money is supporting this. The September report (500 words) will explain in some detail how the award has helped you to get closer to achieving your musical goals and how it has assisted your musical development..

The Award will be overseen, and applications assessed, by the LMW Award Panel (the Panel) to be appointed and chaired by the MD. The Award will be made annually (usually late in the third school term of each year and subject to a suitable application being received by the Award Panel). Applications for the Award will be invited and subsequently accepted each year from registered members of LMW. The timing of the call for applications etc. shall be set by the Band Committee as it sees fit.

The Panel, in assessing applications for the Award, should take into account:

- a) The applicant's goals in applying for the Award.
- b) How the Award might help achieve those goals.
- c) The potential benefit to the band from the applicant's continued membership.
- d) Any other factors which the Panel may wish to take into account.

The closing date for applications for the Award shall be the last Wednesday of June each year.
